<u>READING TOP TIP</u>: Our top tip this week is: <u>Enjoy bedtime stories</u>. Read with your child at bedtime as often as you can. It's a great way to end the day and to spend valuable time with them. Sharing a book at bedtime helps develop your child's vocabulary, gets them used to the idea of regular reading, and gives you both a great opportunity to bond.

<u>PHOTOGRAPHS</u>: Your child should have brought home the 'proof' of their annual school photograph. Parents need to make payment on line with John Hunt photography. These photographs do make fantastic Christmas presents for loved ones and provide wonderful memories of your child - we all know, they grow up so fast!

<u>COLLECTION AT HOME TIME</u>: Home time is a busy time and our staff have a big responsibility to ensure that your child is handed over to the parent/guardian who is coming to collect. We have put a one way system in place to help keep everyone in the community safe. Yes, this means, parents/guardians have to wait patiently in the queue at the gate and further to walk because you have to walk the perimeter of the school. We have over 200 children that need to be dismissed so let's all work together so this is done in an orderly and safe fashion. A letter detailing the arrangements for parents has been distributed today and children have also been informed about the arrangements.

<u>YEAR 6 PARENTS</u>: Our Lady's R.C. High School invite parents and pupils to their open evening event next Thursday, 26th September. Furthermore, the school is offering 1:1 tours for parents whilst the school is in operation.
